- o Subscriptions not paid by 15th March mean a 40 day delay before BDI cover becomes effective
- o "All colonies must be insured" "Where at the time of inspection by a duly authorised Bee Inspector, the number of colonies managed exceeds the number for which a premium has been paid, no cover will apply under the policy. When determining the number of colonies to insure, potential increases must be taken into consideration."
- o A colony is any hive regardless of size. A nucleus, a swarm, each is classed as a colony.
- o Associate members (who must be members of a beekeeping Association affiliated to the BBKA) will not receive official literature from BBKA etc. via this Association. BBKA literature etc. will be supplied via the Association of which they are a full member.
- o This Association is affiliated to the BBKA so membership (fully paid up members only) gives Third Party insurance cover. This does not cover the beekeeper's family unless they are members in their own right
- o Third party insurance does not cover vandalism or theft. Cover for these risks is available through BBKA at extra cost. Details are available at www.beekeeperinsurance.co.uk
- o The Association officers are not legal or insurance experts, and any statement, whilst made in good faith, may not be legally binding.
